- This Technology application is about you. While the evaluators appreciate everything your
  parents and family have done for you (so have the other applicants) it is assumed that they have
  and will help you however they can. Relieving the financial burden on them is understood. The
  Committee is interested in how this Technology Award will impact you and help you fulfill your
  educational dreams. Focus on you.
- The Class of 2025 (CFY) has thirty-nine members and ten devices are available. This is a competitive process. Not everyone will need a new device so explaining your "why" to finish in the top 25% is particularly important.
