The CFY/SPC (St. Petersburg College) Scholarship Program is partnership between both organizations based upon the joint commitment to the youth of Pinellas County via offering educational opportunities to graduating Pinellas County seniors with an emphasis on financial needs based and involvement with CFY sponsored programs during their childhood. The CFY organization believes that through youth athletics many life skills are learned to create great citizens in our community and annually financially supports thousands of Pinellas County Children's access to community-based youth athletics programs.

CFY through its Richard O. Jacobson Post Secondary Scholarship Program has provided over \$2,000,000 since 2013 to almost four hundred graduating seniors and education support makes up 23% of CFY's annual giving.

The CFY/SPC Scholarship Program is only for students looking to attend St. Petersburg College to participate in a Two-Year Associate Degree program and the scholarship is not transferable to any other school and is available for three years to cover the cost of tuition, books, and fees after other possible financial aid has been applied.
