ROJ & CFY/SPC POST-SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIPS

Starting in 2024, CFY has partnered with St. Petersburg College to provide 10 scholarships worth \$9,000 payable over 2 years to a Pinellas County graduating Senior who will be attending St. Petersburg College. CFY's 2024 Richard O. Jacobson (ROJ) and newly added CFY/ SPC Postsecondary Scholarship Program as reached new heights with a total of \$250,000 to be awarded this summer. Since the program's inception CFY has given over \$1,150,000 in scholarships. The final distribution of awards includes: eight \$10,000 college/university awards, ten full books and tuition St. scholarships, Pete College thirteen \$5,000 college/university awards, \$3.500 and one technical/trade awards, for a total of 30 lives impacted. Each honoree had the opportunity to meet their scholarship sponsor at "Breakfast at the Ballpark", sponsored by the Philadelphia Phillies at their Spring Training home away from home on March 4th.

CONTINUOUS GIVING AWARD

CFY Grant Program now includes an Arts & Culture Registration Reimbursement category that will facilitate access to programs like those offered at the Dunedin Fine Art Center to a greater number of children enrolled in Title 1 schools across Pinellas County with awarding \$22,500 for the student registrations for Summer Camps and their After School Program as well as their Wheels on Wheels Program. Secondly, as CFY expands relationship with Pinellas Sheriff and the Sheriff's PAL Boxing Program grows in support with a \$33,00 donation to continue their programming.



KICK OFF TO WATER SAFETY

the Title 1 Water Safety Program which was piloted in 2022 with two schools (Belleair and SkyCrest) by providing transportation and water safety shirts. In 2023 we supported five schools serving 1,300 students in grades kindergarten through second with lifesaving in-water skills for two weeks. So far in 2024 CFY has served three schools: McMullen Booth, Eisenhower and Mount Vernon (the first school in St Petersburg) Elementary. With More schools scheduled for 2024.



PROGRAM WORKSHOP

Second annual CFY program workshop sponsored by Big Storm Brewery was held on January 30, 2024, where over 30 youth sport and program providers attended to learn more about CFY's expanded geographic support, grant program offerings and ways they may assist with working with the CFY Network of funding partners to further expand funding to open up access to all youth regardless of their ability to pay registration fees.



GRANTS AWARDED

In the first grants cycle awarded over \$30,000 in aAthlete Scholarship Reimbursement and Equipment Supplement. In this cycle the grants impacted 7 different programs including: Knights Lacrosse Foundation, Team Under Pressure Basketball Club, Upper Pinellas Football, Burg Baseball, Safety Harbor Little League, Oldsmar Little League and Largo Seminole Basketball.
