



The following is an inclusive list of CFY Richard O. Jacobson sponsored Post Secondary Scholarships, the name of the scholarship and background on the award and the preferences of the donor. As you are applying, please keep these thoughts in mind as you are writing and posting information. Scholarships winners will be matched with the best "match" of a donor based upon these criteria. This is **not** the only evaluation tool used but used by the scholarship committee. However, weight is given to individuals who match some of the desired values and characteristics.



• Fred Fisher Memorial Scholarship (sponsored by the Long Center Foundation) – Mr. Fisher was the founder of the Long Center as well as one of the original founders of CFY almost 60 years ago utilizing his time, treasure, and network to expand opportunities for the youth of Pinellas County through youth athletics. As a champion for underserved youth, Mr. Fisher priority was opening access to the value of youth sports to all children and basic swim skills so all youth may thrive. Values and inspiration of hard work as well as financial need and assistance are priorities in the awarding of this scholarship.



Don Zimmer Memorial Scholarship (sponsored by the Tampa Bay Rays) - Don Zimmer was a dedicated sponsor of CFY and attended many CFY events including the infamous "Zim Roast". His 65-year professional baseball career is only surpassed by his love of family and Soot, his bride of 63 years. This scholarship is for a graduating Pinellas County baseball player who exhibited the values of the team, being a great teammate, giving your best effort each day and giving back to the community.



• Angelo Dundee Memorial Scholarship (sponsored by Terri Dundee Coughlin and Jim Dundee) -Mr. Dundee was a big supporter of CFY with his time and his boxing treasures. As the former trainer to Muhammad Ali and Sugar Ray Leonard to name a few, Mr. Dundee was involved in many of professional boxing's greatest fights.
